

These rules are applicable for all male and female students K-12 of Eastern York School District.

Specific Guidelines for the Dress Code:

- 1. Immodest or transparent clothing is not acceptable.**
- 2. Shoes and clothing that may be damaging to school property or hazardous to others are prohibited.**
- 3. Shoes without backs, such as flip flops, are not permitted. Sandals are discouraged. Bare feet are permitted only in the locker rooms at the secondary level.**
- 4. The wearing of outerwear; including coats, jackets, windbreakers, pullover windbreakers, and the like is prohibited indoors.**
- 5. Clothing should not be too short, too tight, attention getting, suggestive or revealing.**
- 6. Tank tops must have at least one-inch straps for High School Students. Tank tops must cover shoulders for Middle School and Elementary Students.**
- 7. Sleeveless shirts are permitted, but cannot reveal the sides of the torso.**
- 8. Clothing, jewelry and grooming practices, which depict words, signs, pictures or any combination and advocate or promote sexual activity, violence or the use of alcohol/drugs or demeans /degrades another because of race, national origin, handicap or disability is prohibited.**
- 9. All shorts must have a minimum of a four (4) inch inseam - for both males and females**

Examples of inappropriate school apparel include, but are not limited to, the following:

- ◆ **Pajamas and/or slippers**
- ◆ **Visible undergarments**
- ◆ **Sunglasses, caps, hats or any type of head covering.**
- ◆ **Head (forehead), wrist, or leg bands.**
- ◆ **Large decorative chains worn as necklaces or bracelets. Wallet/pocket chains, jewelry with spiked, sharp, or protruding parts that can inflict damage or harm. (The administration reserves the right to determine what are excessive and inappropriate amounts of jewelry.)**
- ◆ **Pants/shorts with printing on the backside.**
- ◆ **Midriff shirts or blouses (students must be able to raise their hands above their heads without seeing midriff area.)**
- ◆ **Shoes with wheels in them.**
- ◆ **Tube tops, tank tops, spaghetti strap tops, etc.**

The administration reserves the right to make the final decision on appropriate dress.

Consequences for inappropriate dress may include but are not limited to:

- √ **Requiring the student to change clothes.**
- √ **Calling home and having parent/relative bring a change of clothes.**
- √ **Sending the student home.**
- √ **Taking disciplinary measures.**
