



We are pleased to introduce the “Wrightsville Reads!” program to our students and families of Wrightsville Elementary. We designed this program to encourage students to spend time reading the books and magazines they enjoy outside of the school day. In summary, the program establishes a monthly amount of time that each student will attempt to read to meet the goal (sample table below). Students will complete a chart each month to track the minutes read (each month is a different color). We are asking an adult to sign off on the sheet to verify the recorded time before submitting it to the teacher at the end of the month.

* Note: Students in kindergarten and first grade may reach this goal by sitting and listening to an adult read when appropriate. Additionally, the goals **may** be altered for individual students and/or students in the I.U. and Transition classrooms.

To encourage student participation, we offer the following incentives: If the goal is met . . .

6 of the 8 months – These students will enjoy an ice cream social celebration in June.

7 of the 8 months – These students will receive a ticket to a York Revolution baseball game (with a voucher for food and other small prizes) in addition to the ice cream social.

All 8 months! – Students who hit the goal every month will have their name entered in a drawing to participate in a “Students vs. Staff” basketball game at the end of the year (roughly 20-30 names will be selected per grade level). They will also participate in the ice cream social and receive a ticket to see the York Revolution.
