



Eastern York Names New Superintendent Joseph Mancuso to Lead the District

WRIGHTSVILLE, PA. April 2, 2018. The Eastern York Board of School Directors has appointed Dr. Joseph Mancuso as the district's next superintendent. Dr. Mancuso will begin leading the district on July 1, 2018.

Dr. Mancuso currently serves as the Assistant Superintendent of the South Middleton School District. He has spent his entire career at South Middleton moving through the ranks as a teacher, coach, and building level administrator.

"The Board is excited to bring Dr. Mancuso into the district," Board President Mark Keller said. "He brings a wealth of experience, knowledge and a real passion for leadership, all of which will make him a great fit for Eastern York," Keller added.

Dr. Mancuso received his bachelor's degree from Edinboro University, his master's in educational administration (along with his elementary and secondary principals' certification) from Shippensburg University, and a doctorate from Widener University. "I am ready to get to work in Eastern York. The process has given me an opportunity to get to know the Board as well as administrators, teachers and some community members. I look forward to working with everyone to serve the students and families of the district," Mancuso said.

"We also want to express our deepest appreciation to Dr. Darla Pianowski for serving the Eastern York School District so well through the years, especially as our superintendent for the last 12 years," Keller said. "Under her leadership, we are in a very good position to move forward under Dr. Mancuso's leadership."

The next step will be for the Board and Dr. Mancuso to continue working on a comprehensive entry plan, superintendent evaluation process, and other strategic governance procedures to create the conditions for a successful future for Eastern York.
