## GRADUATION INFORMATION PRACTICE--BEHAVIORAL EXPECTATIONS--OBLIGATIONS

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The end of the school year is rapidly approaching and with that comes Commencement! This letter is to inform you of our expectations for student behavior as it relates to the end-of-year activities leading up to the Commencement ceremony at 6:30 p.m. on June 2, 2017 and to provide you with details of your son/daughter's last few weeks at Eastern York High School.

This is an exciting time for seniors, so it is very important that they meet all of their obligations, i.e., those outlined in this letter, those outlined by their class advisors, those outlined by their teachers, and any financial obligations. All obligations, including financial obligations, must be fulfilled before the first day of commencement practice, May 30, 2017.

The end of the year activities begin Tuesday, May 23, 2017 with senior finals, senior make-up examinations, the class trip, practices for Commencement, and the Commencement ceremony.

We earnestly request your son or daughter be made fully aware that no arrangements or commitments should be made that conflict with this pre-announced schedule. As has been past practice, if students do not participate in the senior trip, they are to report to the high school at the regular time.

All Commencement practices are mandatory. Caps and gowns will be distributed the week of practice. The price of the caps and gowns will be determined, with a maximum cost of \$10 per student. All seniors must be **present and on time for all practices** and the **Commencement ceremony -no exceptions!** If a student is unable to attend due to a medical emergency, a physician's note will be required. If a senior is late to Commencement practice, he/she will be required to serve detention that day making up for allotted time. If detention is not served, the student will not be permitted to participate in the Commencement ceremony. If a student misses a Commencement practice, the student will not be permitted to participate in the Commencement ceremony. We do not have a lot of time

to prepare for the ceremony, so it is vital that everyone is at practice and on time each day. All obligations must be fulfilled Tuesday, May 30.

**Students should make arrangements with work--NO ONE WILL BE PERMITTED TO ARRIVE LATE AND/OR LEAVE EARLY!**

On the evening of Commencement, seniors shall park at the Middle School by 5:35 p.m. (Seniors will enter the High School through the science wing entrance. A map with entrance points into the high school is included for your convenience.) Additionally, during their final days at Eastern York, we expect the seniors to continue to adhere to the Student Code of Conduct. Students who violate the Code, dependent upon the severity of the infraction, may not be permitted to commence with their classmates. For participation in the Commencement ceremony, Seniors must wear unmodified caps and gowns. Failure to comply with this requirement may be deemed as insubordination and could cause exclusion from the ceremony. The Commencement Ceremony is a privilege and honor for students, not a right!


Commencement will be held on June 2, 2017, at 6:30 p.m. in the High School Gymnasium. Doors will open at 6:00 p.m. Seniors must arrive by 5:45 p.m. All gentlemen who are graduating must wear a dress shirt, a tie, socks, dress shoes (no sneakers), and dress pants (no jeans). All ladies who are graduating must wear a skirt, dress or dress pants (no jeans) and dress shoes. Commencement is a momentous occasion and requires a certain solemnity to honor the occasion. We trust each family will assist with communicating this to their seniors. Students should remain dignified and respectful throughout the Commencement. Any student who disrupts the ceremony with beach balls, noise makers, silly string or any other item or actions which draw undue attention, may be removed from the ceremony and escorted out of the gymnasium by an administrator. If a student is removed from the ceremony, they must call the high school office and make an appointment to meet with Dr. Mitzel to receive their diploma. Balloons are not permitted in the gymnasium or Performing Arts Center.

Graduates will be issued a minimum six (6) tickets for Commencement. If more tickets are needed, please have your graduate speak with Mr. Hopper or Ms. Doutrich on the first day of practice. Other guests can sit in the Performing Arts Center and watch the ceremony (no ticket required). Refer to the enclosed map for entrances to the Performing Arts Center.

A parking map with traffic flow patterns will be posted on the website closer to graduation. There will be three shuttles to pick up guests at various locations in the high school and middle school parking lots. Also, a limited number of handicapped parking spaces will be available in the stadium lot. If you require handicap parking, please contact the high school office for a pass to get into the handicap parking area.

For your information, local churches sponsor a Baccalaureate Service to honor graduating seniors. This year the service for our seniors will be held at Valley View Alliance Church, 200 Alliance Avenue, York, PA at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 1, 2017. Seniors are invited to attend this service, but it is not mandatory. Cap and gowns should be worn.



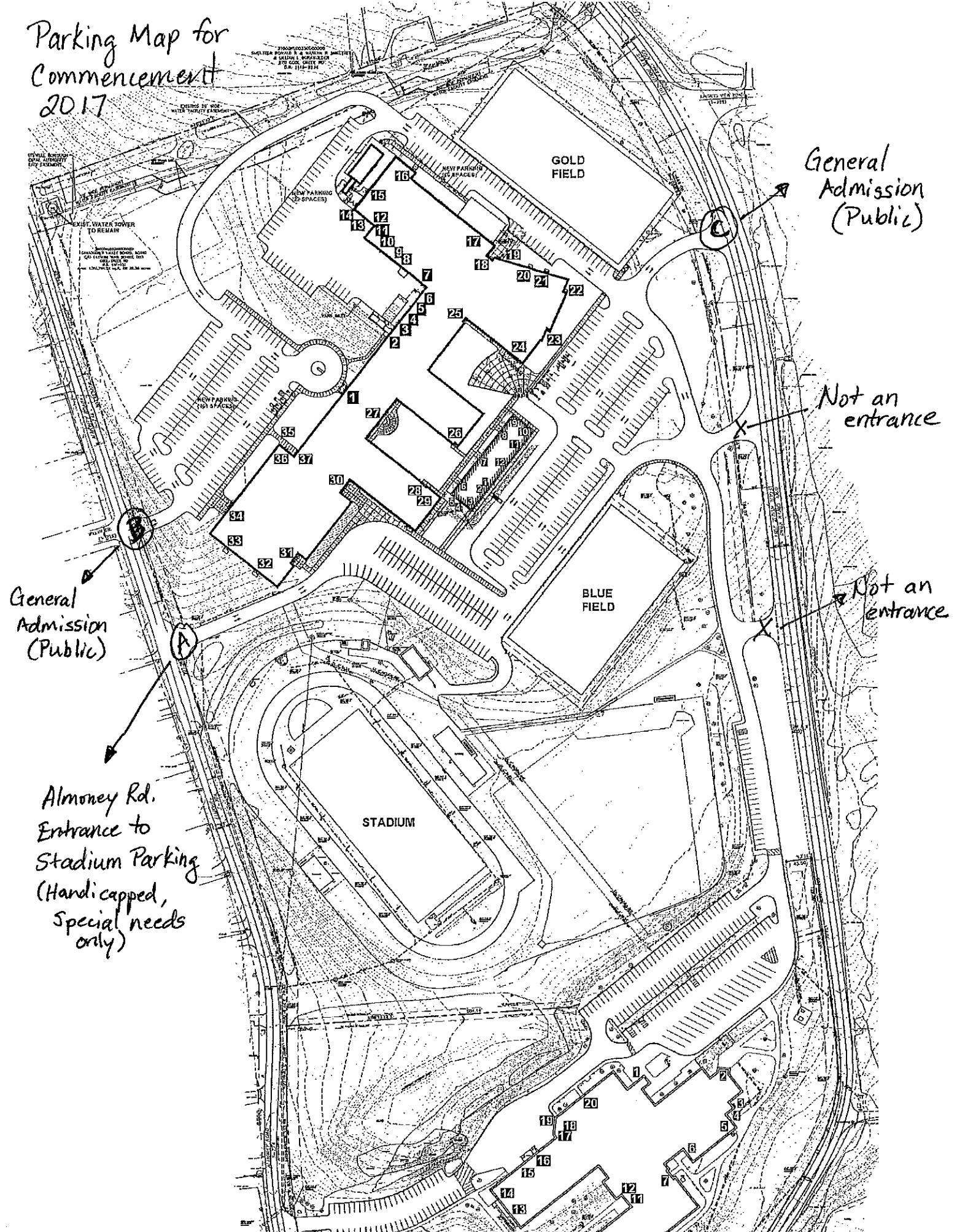
