1. Tell me about yourself.
2. What are your career plans? Why do you want to work in this area?
3. What qualifications do you have that make you feel that you will be successful in your field?
4. Last year, how many days of work (or school), did you miss? How many days were you late?
5. Have you ever had difficulty getting along with fellow students?
6. What have you done that shows initiative?
7. What do you think you might enjoy the most? The least? Why?
8. What is your major strength? Weakness?
9. Give an example of a major problem you faced and how you solved it.
10. Do you feel that you have done the best scholastic work of which you are capable?
11. Would you rather be in charge of a project or work as part of a team? Why?
12. What personal characteristics are necessary for success in your chosen field?
13. How do you spend your spare time?
14. What would previous employers say about you?
15. In what school activities have you participated?
16. How do you handle rejection?
