

**EASTERN YORK HIGH SCHOOL
GRADUATION PROJECT
MOCK INTERVIEW**

In their senior year, students will participate in a mock interview based upon their graduation project. Students will have the opportunity to attend an informational session on interviewing tips in preparation for the mock interview. A rubric will be presented to the students prior to the interview, and that same rubric will be used to evaluate the mock interview. A grade of 70% or above on the rubric will be considered acceptable.

Interviews will take place in front of an interview panel consisting of Eastern York School District staff members, community volunteers and business leaders.

The purpose of the mock interview is to provide students an opportunity to demonstrate their ability in several areas. The areas to be addressed include:

- Appearance
- Preparation
- Conversation
- Maturity/Composure
- Awareness
- Self-Confidence/Poise
- Sociability
- Manners

Apart from the interview, the panel is responsible for determining whether the students have met the written and project components of the graduation project. If these components have been completed and the mock interview is acceptable, the graduation project will be considered completed and acceptable.
